4-H Judging Contests

The 4-H judging contests will be held **Saturday, April 13, 10:00 a.m.—12:00 p.m. in the Extension Exhibit Hall.** The following contests will be offered for Coverbud, ages 5-7, and Cloverleaf members ages 8 and 9: horticulture, entomology, and photography. Juniors, ages 10-13, and Seniors, ages 14-18, may participate in the following contests: photography (must submit photographs and complete skills judging), horticulture, seed identification, forestry, and entomology. This year, we are adding the Bicycle Contest for ages 8-18. (We must have at least 5 registered for bicycle in order to set up the contest.) Contest information and study material for these contests are available in the county office.

You may participate in up to three judging contests. **Please call and sign up for the contests you would like to participate in by Wednesday, April 10.** If no one has registered for a contest by April 10, that contest will not be offered.

4-H Clothing Construction & Selection Contests

The clothing construction & selection contests will be held **Saturday, April 13, at 10:00 a.m.,** at the Extension office. **Please register for one or both of these contests by Wednesday, April 10.** Project books and study packets for these contests are available at the Extension office.

Clothing Construction: 4-H members ages 10-18, can participate in the contest. There are four project levels based on sewing ability. There are four parts to the clothing construction contest: **1.** The 4-H member must construct a garment according to the correct project level. You should bring your garment to the contest on a hanger for the judges to look at. 2. You will model your garment for the judges. **3.** Participate in a skill-a-thon. Examples of stations include: parts of a sewing machine, sewing equipment, pattern markings, use of a pattern envelope, types of fabrics, kinds of buttons, selection of fabric, interfacing, lining and notions. Two stations will be set up for the county contest. 4. The final part of the contest will consist of ranking a set of 4 samples according to construction quality and present oral reasons on how you ranked the samples.

Clothing Selection: 4-H members 5-18, can participate in the contest. Each contestant will model a ready to wear outfit, which he/she has purchased. You will give oral reasons about the suitability of the outfit selected. Reasons should include statements such as why the outfit is appropriate for the occasion you purchased it for, care requirements, material content, and statements about the construction quality of the outfit.



NE District 4-H Shooting Sports Competition

The deadline to register for the 2024 NE District 4-H Shooting Sports competition is Wednesday, April 10. Participants must have met the following qualifications to compete: 8 hours of safety training per discipline and a qualifying postal score for each event. The NE District Event will be held Saturday, April 27, at the Jimmy Bryan 4-H Youth Complex in West Point and the Starkville Gun Club (Shotgun only). Entry fees are \$10.00 per class. Come by the Extension to complete your registration.

Please help us create the 2024 Annalisa Laudadio race t-shirt. This contest is open to youth and adults.

Contest rules and conditions:

A replica of the winning design will be featured on the race T-shirt. Entries should be submitted on white, unlined, letter sized (8 1/2" x 11") paper.

- Designs can be original artwork or computer generated. Only twodimensional designs will be accepted.
- Color designs are encouraged but the design may not be printed in the exact colors on the T-shirt.
- When using the 4-H Clover, the emblem must adhere to the rules outlined in the 4-H National Headquarters Fact Sheet: Using the 4-H Name and Emblem.
- The 4-H T-Shirt Design selection committee reserves the right to modify the winning design.
- The selection committee will review all entries and will choose the best design based on creativity, originality, and uniqueness.
- Include your first and last name and phone number on the back of the design.

The winner will receive a free 5K t-shirt and their choice of a free 5K entry or a \$20 prize. **The entry deadline is Friday, May 24, 2024.**
