

Process

- Clean your glass
- Cut out or apply bought stencils
- Make sure to put masking tape around edges
- Use craft stick to press bubbles out of stencils
- Apply etching cream
- Wait about 10 minutes
- Rinse with warm water
- Voila!! You have personalized glassware
